2015: independent living and political participation






Organizational Learning Process of the Department

- "conference": designations as barriers
- persons with cognitive challenges (SelbstvertreterInnen) as speakers
- persons with cognitive challenges as an audience: moderation, conservative presentation techniques
- preparation: workshops on easy language/ moderation
- contact persons with disabilities
- summaries in easy language in advance
